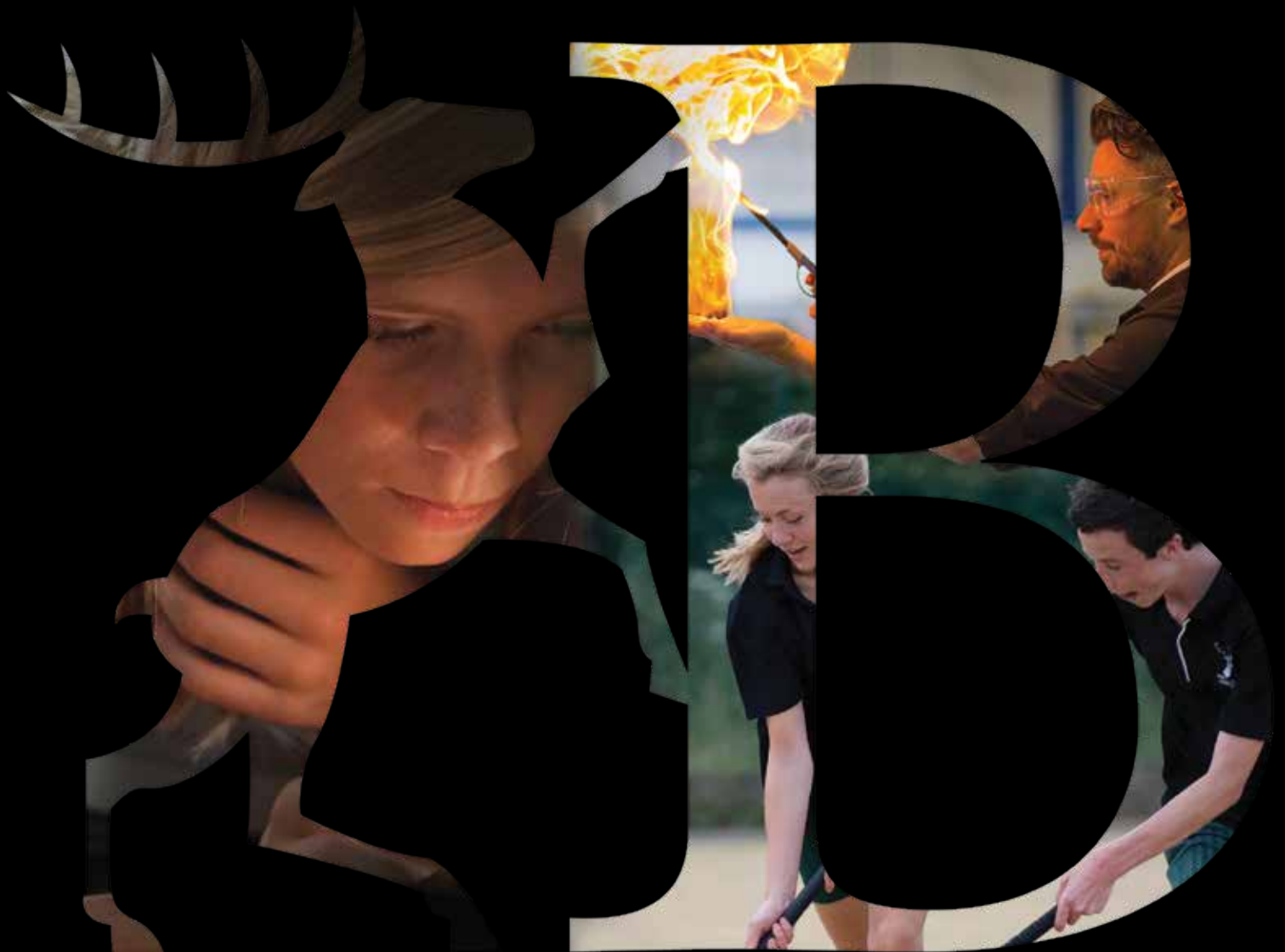

We promote a strong sense of self-worth combined with a respect for others. Consistently high expectations are embedded within an environment that is founded on mutually respectful relationships between students, staff and parents. After joining Bohunt Wokingham, students will be placed into houses, each of which has a tutor group from each year. The Houses are effectively small schools within the School, which enable students to support each other and assume leadership under the guidance of tutors, Achievement Coordinators and Senior Leaders. The House system ensures that our young people are nurtured during the transition from their Primary Schools and throughout their journey with us. Our learners' sense of ownership and belonging is fostered by encouraging them to perform in school assemblies, help maintain the school environment, support local charities and represent the school in local, national and international contexts.

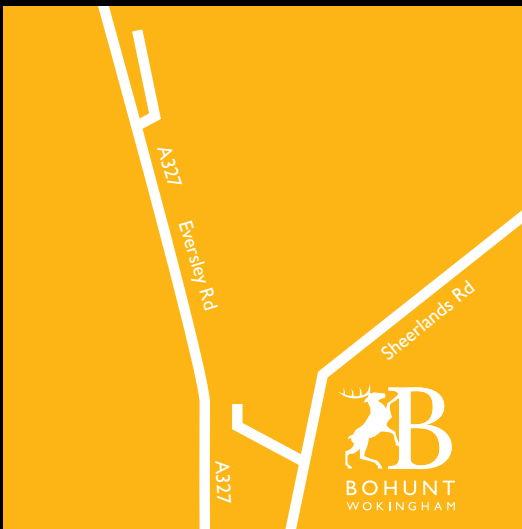
# Leadership.

We give our learners the opportunity to develop the mindset, skills and confidence to become leaders.

Opportunities for students attending Bohunt School Wokingham include:

- International Expeditions to the Arctic and Kyrgyzstan in order to complete scientific research on space, meet local people and trek in remote, wilderness locations.
- An extensive outdoor programme including an activity camp for all Year 8s, a bushcraft camp for Year 9s and the Duke of Edinburgh Award.
- Annual ski-trips and sporting tours.
- Fieldtrips to Iceland, Naples, Space Camp in Belgium and a variety of British locations.
- Many opportunities for performance during events such as local festivals, Bohunt's own BEXAFEST, school musicals, variety shows and weekly school assemblies.
- Dance, Language and Sports Leaders Awards.
- Head Boy and Head Girl positions.
- Bohunt's STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Maths) Festival and events with our STEM Partner organisations, 3M, LEGO, and Honda.
- An exciting range of other residential trips.





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
