25 August 2022: Students at Bohunt Wokingham, which is part of Bohunt Education Trust (BET), are celebrating today after receiving their GCSE results, enabling them to embark on the next stage of their education journey.

Students and staff joined together to mark the achievements of the 2022 cohort, who have shown great commitment, determination and hard work over the last few years to secure our first set of strong examination results.

A great many achievements were celebrated across the school, with particular standout individual highlights including:

- **Anika D** who achieved grade 9s in all 10 of her GCSE courses
- **Adam C** with 9 grade 9s and one grade 8
- **Dan E** and **Ethan S** both with 8 grade 9s, one grade 8 and one grade 7
- **Juliet D** with 7 grade 9s and two grade 8s

Results were strong in a wide number of subjects and reflect the students' hard work and support of staff in such a unique set of circumstances and we are delighted that more than 80% of students gained grade 4's in both English and Maths. Amongst the top performing subjects were History, Geography, Drama, Triple Science and Health and Social Care. We were also delighted with the first ever results the school has had in Mandarin.

This includes delivering unparalleled educational opportunities and highly effective teaching to nurture and develop students into becoming "game-changers."
