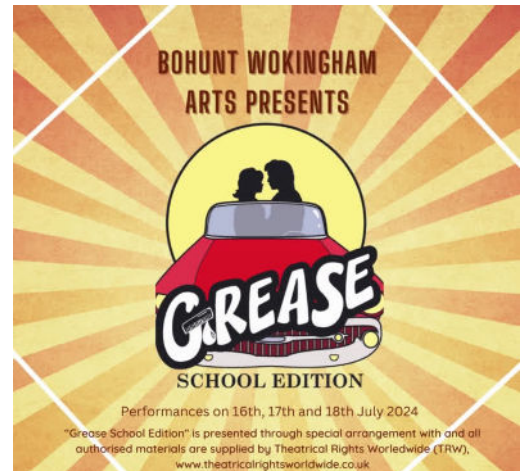

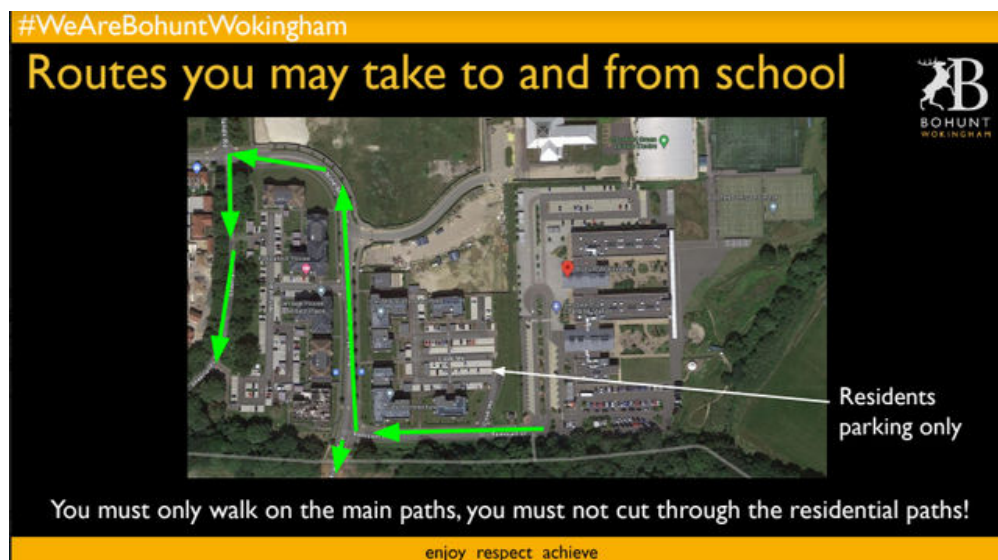


Access to School and Behaviour Expectations

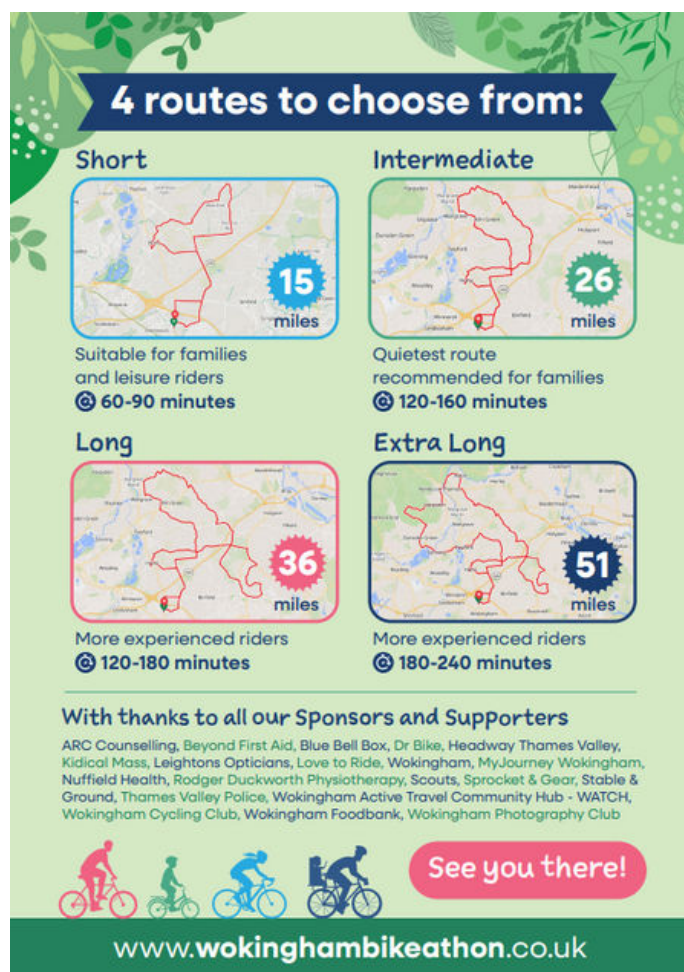

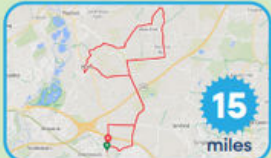
