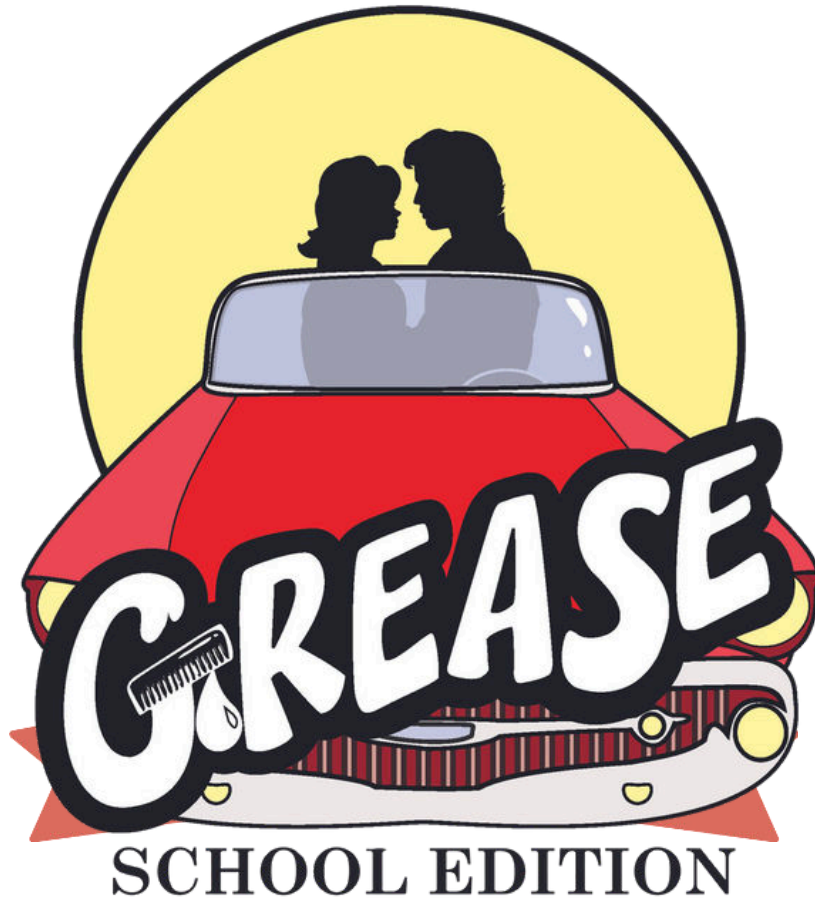

The Gateway will remain open until **Saturday 31st August 2024** and students will then be given their tie(s) when they return in September during tutor time.

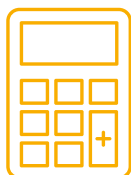
Donations for ECO Projects
