Here's a quick update on what's been happening:

Drama: Creativity and Performance in Action

- Year 9 & 10 GCSE students recently took part in a Devising Workshop with The Prospect Theatre Company, strengthening their creative skills for their upcoming coursework.
- A House competition is being run by Drama in January, providing another exciting opportunity for students to demonstrate their talents and creativity.

Physical Education: Building Resilience and Teamwork

- This half term PE we have been running House Competitions, where students have competed in sports they may not have tried before, further strengthening house spirit and collaboration.
- Nearly 400 students have represented the school in sports fixtures this term, demonstrating resilience and leadership both on and off the field.

- Music Tech students are learning to create music using Logic Pro X and will soon begin their Synoptic Project in January.

As Head of Faculty it has been lovely to see our students' dedication to our subjects and demonstrating their competitive side with their participation in house events.

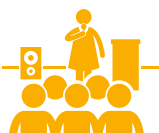
Year 7-9 Voice in a Million Concert (25.11.2024)
