I am the Senior Learning Support Assistant for Communication and Interaction here at Bohunt School Wokingham, where I have had the pleasure of working for almost three years. In this role, I provide tailored support to students with specific SEND needs, implementing 1:1 interventions to help them better understand their diagnoses and supporting their well-being through regular check-ins. I primarily work with students who have diagnoses of Autism, ADHD, Speech, Language and Communication needs but thoroughly enjoy getting to know all of the students.

The school's core values of enjoy respect achieve guide my approach with students, working together to help them feel settled and supported in school. I set high expectations to inspire students to become game-changers in their academic and personal journeys. I regularly encourage students to utilise the unparalleled opportunities offered to them through our co-curricular activities, school trips and getting involved where they can around school to embrace the social aspect of school alongside their academic pursuits. Please also encourage your young people to attend the co-curricular activities. All SEND students are very welcome to attend SEND Study Club Tuesdays through to Fridays. I thoroughly enjoy working with young people. Through collaboration with teachers, specialists, and families, I strive to foster an inclusive environment where every student can achieve their full potential.

Yesterday evening saw one of the highlights of the school calendar with Bohunt's Got Talent. Thank you to all the students and staff who performed and worked tirelessly behind the scenes to make it such a success.
