- His position as CEO meant he could influence the final decision.

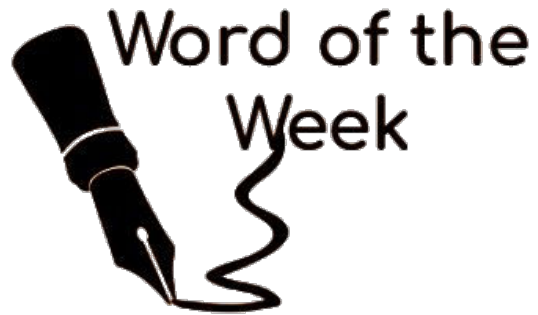
