Could you please ensure that all students come to school with a filled refillable water bottle and that they use the water fountains available to fill this up during break and lunch times.

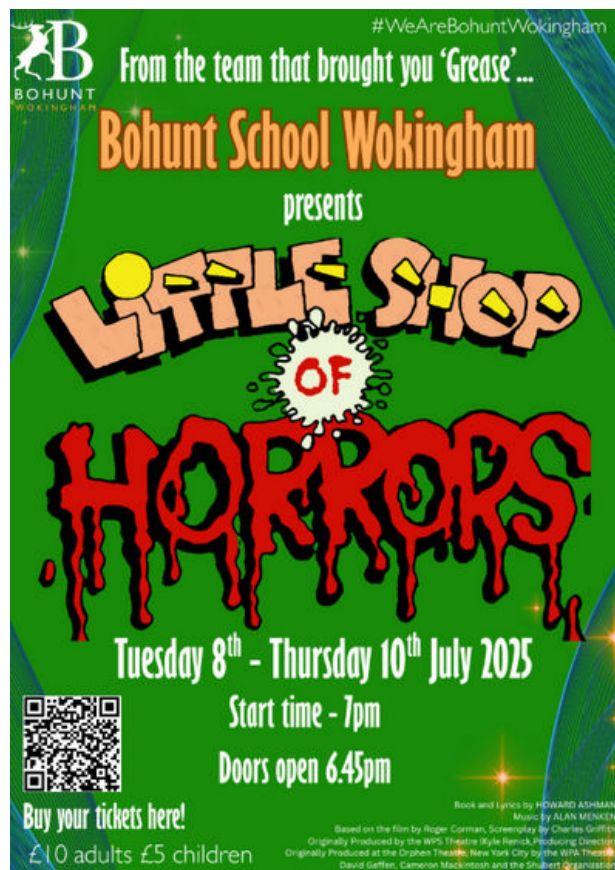
We will continue to monitor the weather over the weekend and will send additional communication should further uniform adaptations be required for Monday.

Heat Health Alert - Amber

Please be informed that the UK Health Security Agency has issued an amber heat-health alert for the South East, which covers Wokingham Borough. The alert is in effect from **27 June 2025 (Friday) at 12:00pm to 1 July 2025 at 06:00pm (Tuesday)**.

Anyone can feel unwell in hot weather, but some groups face higher risks of bad health. This may be due to their medical conditions, or because their 'building blocks of health' are unstable - e.g. housing conditions, working environment, or support in the community. Hot weather can also put pressure on health and care services, or disrupt how they are delivered.
