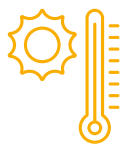

Medical Appointments



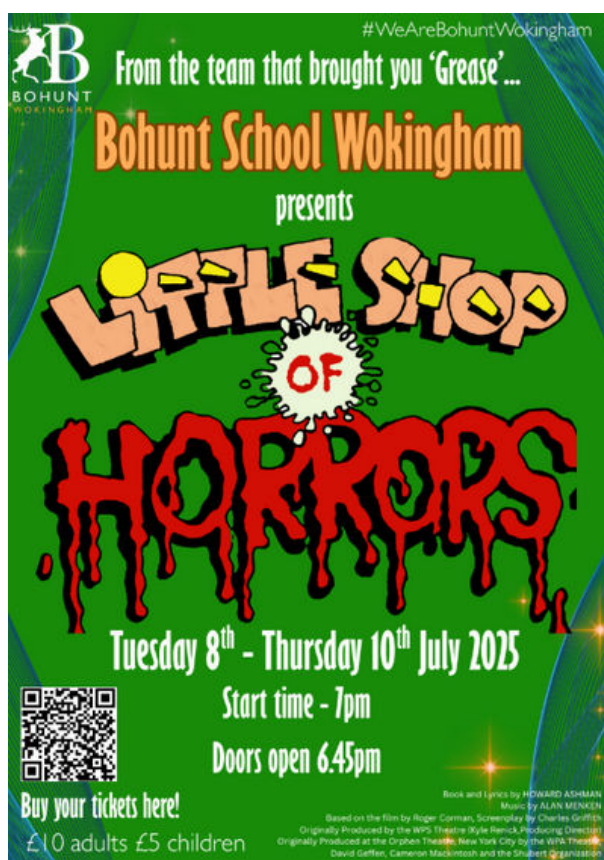
