WEEKEND FLYING CLUBS AT MEMBURY AND POPHAM AIRFIELDS

British Young Pilots are beyond excited to announce that we have just launched brand new weekend flying clubs at our new training centres - Membury Airfield and Popham Airfield!

These sessions run fortnightly over the 10 week term (so 5x sessions in total) to reduce travel time and cost, making this opportunity accessible to as many children as possible.

What's included?

- Fortnightly half day lessons run by a BYP instructor. Half theory based and half practical flying skills on a flight sim.
- Option to have a 30 minute flight in a real aircraft each time child is at the airfield. It is not compulsory to fly every time but we recommend at least 1-2 flights a term!
- Open to all 11-17 year olds.
- For motivated club members, the chance to leave school with a civilian pilots license (PPL).
- £330 per term (+ flights at £90 each)
- The opportunity to be welcomed into a tight-knit community and meet like-minded individuals.
