Welcome from Mr Stromdale - Assistant Head Teacher - Teaching & Learning

I am writing as I watch the construction of our sixth form centre extension in the middle of a cold winter snap. I have seen a worn rectangular grass plain gradually transform in rain and shine. We have seen tough machines that demolished the old building-end stairwell, metal building frames built just like Meccano using immense cranes, safety barrier builders, concrete slab layers, screeding teams and roofers. Currently we have a shell-like structure that looks like a fancy modern car park. The scale of the spaces is impressive and, alongside the architect's illustrations, it gives a real sense of the ambition of Bohunt Wokingham Sixth. We are all extremely excited about welcoming our first sixth form students in September and we are meticulously planning an experience that will truly be an unparalleled opportunity.

It has been a busy autumn term so far. We hosted Welcome Evenings for Year 7 to 10 and enjoyed the company of 540 families across the four nights. We were delighted to see you all again and are most grateful for the kind feedback we received in response to your visits.
