Car Parking

To help keep our school community safe and considerate, we kindly remind drivers to either park fully within a marked parking space (no double parking) or arrive on time for student collection. We also politely ask parents and carers not to park or wait in nearby residential areas, as this can block local residents' driveways and allocated parking bays.

If you are using our designated car park, please follow all signage and the directions given by school staff. There is no stopping in the turning circle at the front of the building at any time. We ask all drivers to be patient, drive carefully while on site, and adhere to the 10mph speed limit.

Where possible, we encourage students to walk, cycle, or use public transport when travelling to and from school. This helps reduce congestion in the car park, particularly during the busy morning and afternoon periods.
