Welcome from Mr Hulland - Assistant Headteacher - Provision & Achievement

Spring has finally arrived, and along with the increase in temperature and several days without heavy rainfall we begin the Year 8 Key Stage 4 (KS4) Options process.

On Tuesday 24th February and Tuesday 3rd March we introduced the process through curriculum meetings with students (assembly) and parents (evening event). Changes at a Government level have influenced altered pathways for students and more freedom of choice for our current Year 8 game-changers.

During the afternoon of Tuesday 10th March, we welcomed an impressive 93% of Year 8 families to our KS4 Options Evening Marketplace event. It was fantastic to see staff sharing their passion for their subjects with such an engaged Bohunt Wokingham community. A reminder to all Year 8 students that the deadline for submitting their options form is Friday 20th March. Students should hand their completed forms directly to their tutors.

This week also saw the return leg of the French Exchange, with families welcoming our French counterparts into their homes from Thursday. We hope the French Exchange students enjoy and gain as much of their English experience as our students did when they visited France earlier this year.

On Thursday evening, we hosted a talk delivered by Olly's Work, a charity established in memory of Olly Stephens following the tragic incident in 2021. The charity works to educate and protect young people from the risks of serious violence and online harm. Olly's parents, Stuart and Amanda Stephens, are passionate advocates for stronger protections for young people online and have worked with the Government in support of the Online Safety Act. As a result, the charity's work is rooted in real-life experience. The session focused on empowering families with the knowledge, awareness, and confidence needed to help keep young people safe. Continuing the discussions of Thursday evening's session with the Olly Stephens Foundation, today Year 10 students took part in a PSHE-themed Drop Down Day. This formed a crucial part of their wider personal development programme and was designed to provide them with the vital knowledge and skills needed to stay safe in today's society. Throughout the day, students engaged in learning and discussions around a range of important topics, including Staying Safe at Night, Consent, STIs, and County Lines. Miss Jones, Wider Personal Development Lead, alongside the Year 10 Pastoral Team, were extremely proud of the mature, respectful and thoughtful approach demonstrated by the entire year group.

As we head into the weekend I would like to take this opportunity to celebrate a number of Co-Curricular sporting achievements over the past few weeks. Both our U13 Boys and Girls Handball teams will be representing Bohunt in the Nationals (at Stoke Mandaville) having qualified through the Berkshire County Rounds. Our U12 and U15 Girls Football teams are in the Berkshire County Cup Semi-Finals, whilst our U12 & U13 Girls, U12, U13 and U16 Boys have all qualified for the EBSFA Semi-Finals. To add to this we have a number of teams representing us in National Rugby Competitions in the coming weeks, with Roslyn Park on the horizon for the U14 Boys and U16 Girls, alongside the ISA 7's and Duke Touch Tournament.
