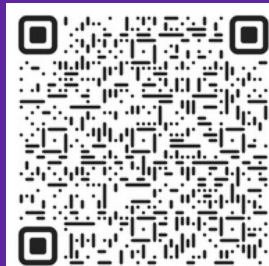

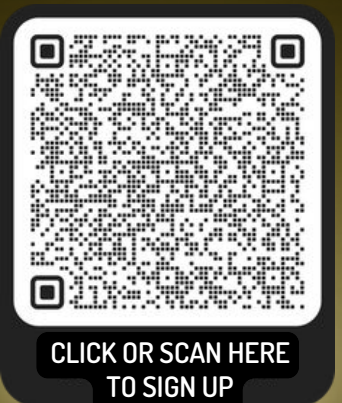

Your teacher will get in touch with you directly to arrange the day/time of the lesson. Lessons are paid for termly.
