Welcome from Mrs Whearity - Head of Outdoor Education and Teacher of PE

Welcome to the Summer Term, which has already brought us some wonderful sunshine. In the Outdoor Education Department, this is the time of year when everyone rallies together like Santa's elves, finalising all of our unparalleled opportunities such as residential camps, watersports, Duke of Edinburgh, and The Big Expedition to Thailand. It is also the time of year when we thank, in advance, all the staff and our eager volunteers who give up their evenings and weekends to support the running of these trips.

Last weekend saw 58 of our Year 10 students complete their Silver Duke of Edinburgh practice expedition around the Surrey Hills. This involved students hiking for three days and camping for two nights. Each cohort of Duke of Edinburgh students is different, and our current Year 10 group have certainly mastered the "Enjoy" element of the school ethos. The selection of snacks in their bags was sufficient to entice even a local clan of badgers into camp, searching for any leftovers that had not been stored away safely. These students now need to finalise their routes in preparation for their qualifying expedition in the New Forest in early June.

This week across the school community, we have seen our Hospitality and Catering students visit the Shinfield Arms to learn more about catering for the public and the demands of the industry. Today, students across Years 7 to 10 represented the school in the ESAA Track and Field Cup at Palmer Park and the National Touch Rugby Tournament. Tomorrow, our Year 11 students have been invited in for core weekend Maths and English study sessions in preparation for their exams, which begin next week.

On the water, we have completed our final paddleboarding course for Year 8, and next up, Year 7 students will be heading out onto the water. This is a fantastic opportunity for students to try something new or to develop their paddleboarding skills through the three-week programme. As always, we hope the weather stays warm and dry to make any accidental falls into the water a little more enjoyable.

As a department, we understand just how important getting outdoors can be in supporting young people's physical and mental wellbeing. Therefore, we encourage parents to reach out and let us know if there is any way we can support their young person in overcoming any barriers they may face to getting outdoors this summer. Finally, with Game Changers Week just around the corner, please keep an eye out for the final instruction emails arriving in your inboxes. We will also be inviting our Year 7 and Year 8 parents to a final information evening before the residential trips depart in July.

We look forward to sharing another exciting assortment of summer adventures with staff and students this year.
