## Welcome from Mrs Murray, Medical Welfare Officer

As we welcome students back from their half term break, they bring with them the typically British experience of 'all weathers in one day'! It is essential that students come to school prepared, primarily with a filled reusable water bottle, having taken any hayfever medication before arriving at school and having applied suncream if they are to be outside for PE, Co-Curricular Activities or fixtures. Students should be encouraged to eat a healthy breakfast, particularly on PE days, to ensure that they have the energy required for physical activity and can maintain their focus, wellbeing and readiness to learn throughout the school day.
