Welcome from Miss Jones - Teacher of Religious Studies and Wider Personal Development Lead

It has been another busy and enriching week for our students. There have been a range of activities to take part in that have challenged them academically, encouraged personal development and celebrated the diversity of our school community.

On Monday, our Year 8 game-changers participated in a Drop Down Day focused on exploring British Values through a range of engaging activities. Students began by learning about democracy, exploring its history and discussing the importance of voting in modern society before putting their knowledge into practice through a mock election. They also explored the Rule of Law through activities centred on fairness, respect and teamwork. Although the weather required plans to be adapted, students rose to the challenge by creating their own games and establishing rules to ensure fair participation for all.

The day continued with a session on mutual respect and tolerance, where students created identity silhouettes to reflect on the unique experiences, cultures, interests and characteristics that make each person who they are. This prompted thoughtful discussions about how we can show understanding, respect and kindness towards others. Students then finished the day by exploring individual liberty and the balance between freedom and responsibility. Working in groups, they designed their own societies, creating rules, rights and freedoms before tackling a range of challenges that tested their ideas. The activities encouraged students to think critically about their role within a community and the responsibilities that come with individual freedoms. It was fantastic to see students so engaged throughout the day and demonstrating a genuine interest in the themes being explored.

These discussions linked perfectly with our celebration of Culture Day on Monday 8th June which the whole school community engaged with. The theme "Many Voices, One Bohunt Community." Students and staff embraced the occasion by wearing cultural dress and sharing aspects of their heritage and identity. The day provided an important opportunity to celebrate the rich diversity within our school while encouraging meaningful conversations about belonging and respect. Events such as these help to create a stronger sense of community and remind us that our differences are something to be valued and celebrated.

We were also incredibly proud of our Year 8 students who represented the school at the Trust Maths Challenge hosted by Costello School. Competing against teams from across the Bohunt Education Trust, our students demonstrated excellent mathematical ability, determination and teamwork throughout the competition. While they narrowly missed out on overall success, they excelled in the mathematics rounds and represented the school with great enthusiasm and resilience.

As we end the week, a number of students are representing the school at the BET Legacy Cup, embracing the unparalleled opportunities this event provides to develop their skills, build new friendships, and showcase their talents. We wish all those involved the very best of luck and look forward to celebrating their achievements and experiences next week.

It has been wonderful to see our students embracing opportunities both inside and outside the classroom, demonstrating the school values of enjoy respect achieve and community spirit that make Bohunt such a special place to learn.

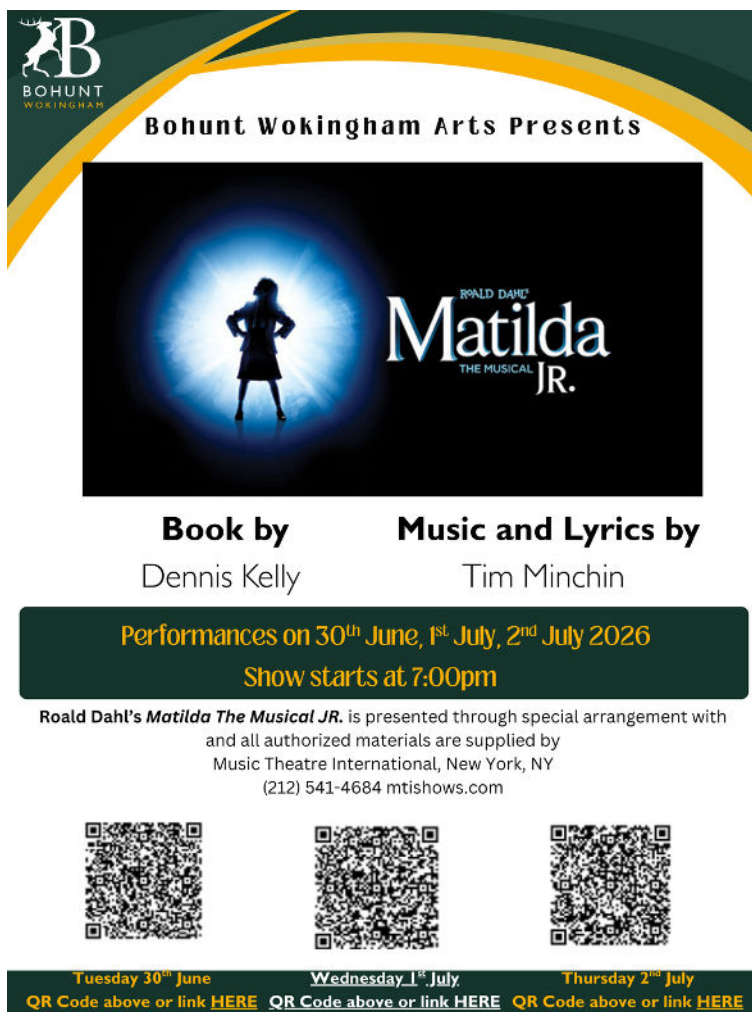

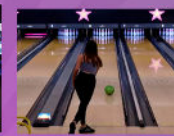
