With the added bonus of glorious weather, it is also fair to say that Selsey's ice cream vendors enjoyed a welcome boost to their usual Monday and Tuesday trade.

One of our biggest House events moves a step closer to its conclusion today as students compete in the MasterChef semi-finals. Participants from across the year groups have been cooking up a storm in pursuit of a coveted place in the final, showcasing an impressive range of culinary skills, creativity and determination. Meanwhile, the Food Technology department faces the enviable challenge of selecting judges, with no shortage of staff eager to sample the competitors' creations.

This week also marks a significant milestone for both Bohunt Wokingham and the Bohunt Education Trust. As excitement continues to build across our school community ahead of the opening of our sixth form, BW6, we were delighted to welcome prospective students to our Year 12 Pre-Enrolment Day. The event provided an opportunity for students planning to join BW6—many of whom are continuing their educational journey with us—to meet staff, learn more about life in the sixth form and begin preparing for the next stage of their education. Seeing so many young people eager to be part of BW6 made the opening of our sixth form feel closer and more tangible than ever before.
